The following decisions made by the HLA years ago created the mess that the owners of lots 13, 14, 16, and 17 have had to deal with for years.

- 1. Turn Hemingway into an all sports lake
- 2. Hire a floating combine to harvest pond weed

Result: Eurasion water milfoil is established in Hemingway Lake a few years later

3. Raising the level of the lake seven and one half inches

Result: Sea walls constructed along the shoreline from Lot 1 to outlot A along the shoreline of Hemingway Heights because of increased shoreline erosion

Result: Increased high speed boating

Result: disappearance of Dave Ostrander's penimcula

6. The establishment of a special assessment district for the control and eradication of nuisance aquatic weeds aith no obvious provisions for cleanup operations for the lake.

Result: Improved conditions for boating

Result: A lot of dead and decaying weeds lying along the shoreline waiting for someone to get them out of the water getting dumped on lots in the Cusenza Landing Subdivision with no discussion or conversation on how to get rid of the weeds we kill.

I am not suggesting that any of the decisions wrong ones or bad ones, but they have not been good some of us

We all contribute to the costs of chemicall treatment of the weeds, but very few of us contribute to the cleanup operation after they are treated. Sometimes, depending on what kind of chemicals are used, a cleanup may not be necessary.

We are asking for a commitment and support froom the HLA to the Marathon Township Board to use the special assessment money for a spring cleanup in the front of these lots. Further, that the Board be allowed to use the money for cleanup operations following each treatment, and further, that the Board, with the consent of the HLA, develop kind of a lake nanagement plan for the removal of dead and decaying weeds and leaves.
