Old Business: Upon review of the draft Solar Energy Ordinance, it was agreed that the buffering/screening language should be more detailed. (See attached). Short Term Rentals: There was much discussion about Short-term Rentals (STR's) such as developing Class I as principle resident owners. Class II Second home or inherited home owners. Class II as owned by a commercial company for the sole purpose of renting out property. All PC members thought that Class III should not be allowed.

As far as the lake district is concerned, there should be limits on how many occupants, (to be determined) the number of vehicles (to be determined) and restricting the # of days to rent out as 3 months per year. Pc determined that the definition of STR should include no less than 7 days and no more than 28 days. Also suggested was that the owner must have ownership for at least 3 months before property could be used as a STR.

Next meeting will be October 9, at 1:00 p.m. A motion was made by Miner with support by Dennis to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 5:10 p.m.
