

TOWNSHIP OF MARATHON
Uniform Traffic Code Ordinance No. 89-1

An ordinance to adopt by reference the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Villages and Township as authorized by Act Number 62 of the Public acts of 1956.

THE TOWNSHIP OF MARATHON ORDAINS:

Section 1. CODE ADOPTED. The Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Villages and Townships promulgated by the Director of State Police and published in the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code and amendments as published in the quarterly supplement number 5 to the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code, in accordance with Public Act 62 of 1956, is hereby adopted by reference.

Section 2. REFERENCES IN CODE. References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages to "governmental unit" shall mean the Township of Marathon.

Section 3. AVAILABILITY OF CODE. The Township Clerk, after publishing this ordinance and a notice of adoption of the Uniform Traffic Code, shall keep a complete copy of the Code available at the Township office for use and inspection by the public.

Section 4. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES APPEALED. All prior ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Uniform Traffic Code ordinance are, to the extent of any inconsistency, hereby repealed.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Uniform Traffic Code Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its date of publication.
