

Notice of Public Hearing on Increasing Property Taxes

The Marathon Township Board

will hold a public hearing on a proposed increase of 0.0322 mills in the operating tax millage rate to be levied on property in 2026

The hearing will be held on : Wednesday August 19, 2026 @ 6:10 pm

Marathon Township Hall 4575 Pine St, Columbiaville MI 48421

The meeting to take action on the proposed additional millage will take place following this public hearing.

If adopted, the proposed additional millage will increase operating revenues from ad valorem property taxes 2.71% over such revenues generated by levies permitted

without holding a hearing. If the proposed additional millage rate is not approved, the operating revenue will increase by 1.33% over the preceding year's operating revenue.

The taxing unit publishing this notice, and identified below, has complete authority to establish the number of mills to be levied from within its authorized millage rate.

Although the proposed 2026 operating millage (1.2214 mills) is lower than the 2025 operating millage (1.2479 mills), Michigan law requires this public hearing because the Township is proposing to levy a millage above the Headlee-reduced maximum authorized rate for 2026.

If your taxable value is \$100,000. Your taxes will be **lower** than last year by \$2.65
The Township is proposing to restore a portion of the Headlee rollback, not the full amount.
